(Completion requirements)

Students must be enrolled in the program for at least three years, earn the prescribed credits, receive the necessary research guidance, and pass the doctoral dissertation review and final examination. However, with regard to attendance period, it is sufficient for those who have made outstanding research achievements to be enrolled for at least one year.

Students must earn at least 8 credits by the following methods.
